What is Women in Recovery?

Women in Recovery is an intensive outpatient treatment program specifically designed as an alternative for women involved in the criminal justice system. This program offers an array of services ranging from housing, to counseling, to drug treatment.

Women in Recovery teaches women about health, wellness, relapse prevention, parenting and building healthy relationships. The program also helps women conquer their drug addiction and acquire the essential economic, emotional and social tools to build successful and productive lives. It is a program for women who want to become positive, contributing members of our community and who believe in the power of change to lead law-abiding lives.



Women in Recovery can help with:

- Housing
- Drug treatment
- Individual and group counseling
- Job search

- Independent living
- Stress reduction and other mind body tools
- Connecting with others who have similar experiences

- A woman who is 18 years and older, involved in the criminal justice system, and has a history of substance abuse or dependence.
