



TULSA COUNTY ACCELERATED ACCOUNTABILITY PROCEDURE

WHAT IS IT?

The Accelerated Accountability Procedure is a new program that will help qualified defendants move through their court proceedings more quickly.

If you qualify for the program and agree to plead guilty to the charge filed by the District Attorney's Office, you will be put on probation and may be ordered to go to counseling or other treatment programs.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The program is for non-violent defendants who have been arrested for a felony crime.

Consideration for the program will be based on:

- Your criminal history
- The current charge(s)
- Screening process
- Recommendations

BENEFITS

This program may:

- Reduce the number of court appearances
- Reduce your stay in jail
- Increase your sentencing options
