

WHAT IS DRUG COURT ?

The Tulsa Drug Court Program is a one-year substance abuse treatment program with a maximum of two years to complete. Treatment is divided into four (4) phase of a minimum of three (3) months each. If a participant successfully completes this program their charges will be dismissed. If not, they will be sentenced to prison.

What to expect in each phase:

Phase I

- You will be required to adhere to the conditions of the performance contract and responsibilities or be subject to sanctions of community service, jail, or other.
- You will be required to attend three, three-hour therapeutic groups and a individual session weekly.
- You will be required to meet with your Probation Officer as ordered.
- You will be required to adhere to a 9:00pm - 6:00am curfew.
- If you're full-time employed or full-time student, you are required to attend three (3) twelve step meetings weekly. If unemployed, part-time employed, or a part-time student, you are required to attend daily twelve step meetings.
- Secure a sponsor, meet and have twelve step sheet signed every other week.
- You will be required to submit to random urine analysis.
- You will be required to appear before the Drug Court Judge weekly.

Phase II

- You will be required to adhere to the conditions of the performance contract and responsibilities or be subject to sanctions of community service, jail, or other.
- You will be required to attend three, three-hour therapeutic groups and BI-weekly individual session.
- You will be required to meet with your Probation Officer as ordered.
- You will be required to adhere to a 9:00pm - 6:00am curfew.
- If you're full-time employed or full-time student, you are required to attend three (3) twelve step meetings weekly. If unemployed, part-time employed, or a part-time student, you are required to attend daily twelve step meetings.
- Secure a sponsor, meet and have twelve step sheet signed every other week.
- You will be required to submit to random urine analysis.
- You will be required to appear before the Drug Court Judge BI- weekly.

Phase III

- You will be required to adhere to the conditions of the performance contract and responsibilities or be subject to sanctions of community service, jail, or other.
- You will be required to attend one, two-hour therapeutic groups and a individual session as prescribed by your primary counselor.
- You will be required to meet with your Probation Officer as ordered.
- You will be required to adhere to a 9:00pm - 6:00am curfew.
- If you're full-time employed or full-time student, you are required to attend three (3) twelve step meetings weekly. If unemployed, part-time employed, or a part-time student, you are required to attend daily twelve step meetings.
- Secure a sponsor, meet and have twelve step sheet signed every other week.
- You will be required to submit to random urine analysis.
- You will be required to appear before the Drug Court Judge every three weeks.

Phase IV

- You will be required to adhere to the conditions of the performance contract and responsibilities or be subject to sanctions of community service, jail, or other.
- You will be required to attend one, two-hour therapeutic groups and a individual session as prescribed by your primary counselor.
- You will be required to meet with your Probation Officer as ordered.
- You will be required to adhere to a 9:00pm - 6:00am curfew.
- If you're full-time employed or full-time student, you are required to attend three (3) twelve step meetings weekly. If unemployed, part-time employed, or a part-time student, you are required to attend daily twelve step meetings.
- Secure a sponsor, meet and have twelve step sheet signed every other week.
- You will be required to submit to random urine analysis.
- You will be required to appear before the Drug Court Judge every four weeks.
